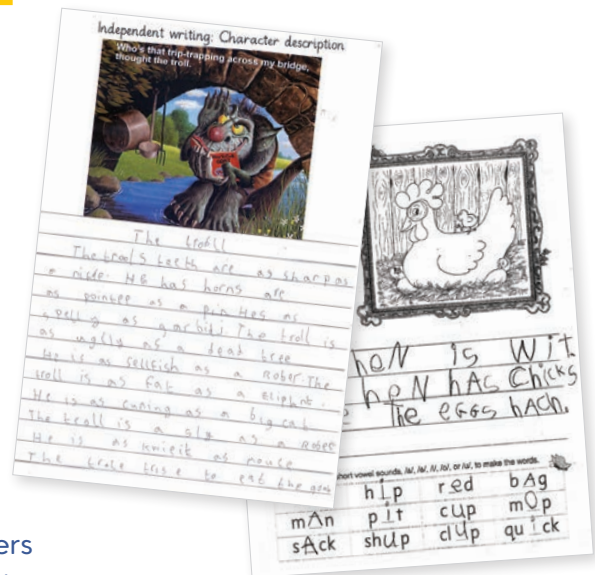

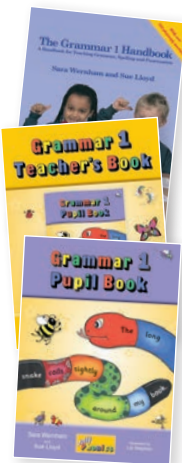

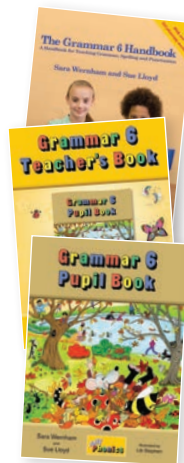

Our Programme

A whole-school approach to high-quality literacy teaching



The programme continues through the school years, by extending the earlier phonics teaching with further spelling, grammar and punctuation concepts. Each year of teaching provides continuous revision and consolidation of topics taught in previous years. This enables children to spell and punctuate more accurately, use a wider vocabulary and have a clear understanding of how language works.

Sample pages show how phonics, grammar, spelling and punctuation concepts are introduced through the programme. These pages are from the Phonics and Grammar Pupil Books. The same content can also be found in the Phonics and Grammar Handbooks.

Phonics (Reception)

Children are taught the 42 letter sounds, how to write them, how to blend the sounds for reading and how to identify the sounds in words for spelling and writing. Alongside this children learn about tricky words as well as being introduced to the alternative spelling of vowels.



Grammar (Years 1-6)

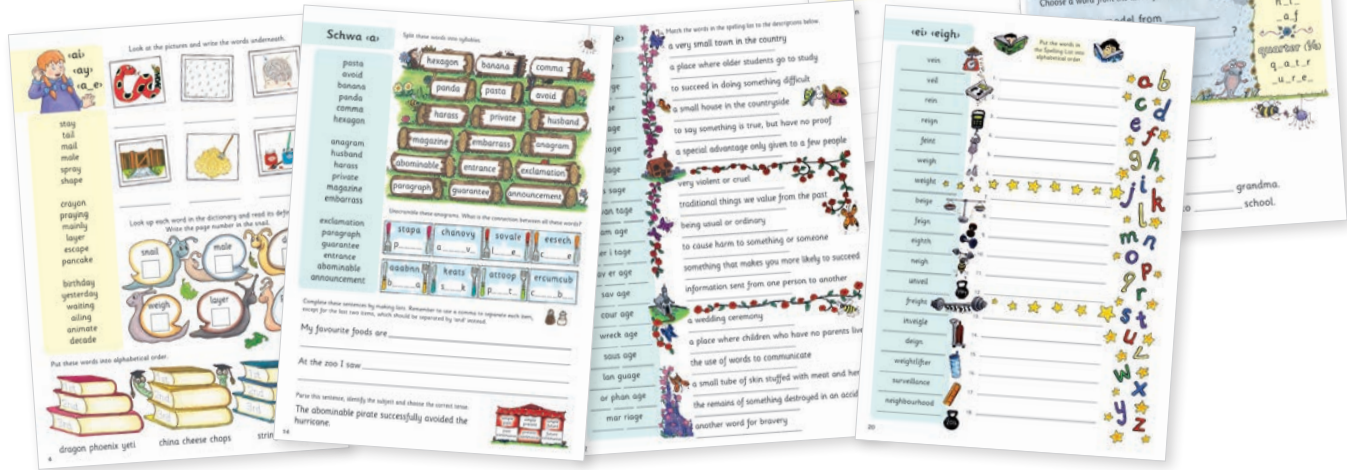
Children are introduced to parts of speech to include nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions and conjunctions. Colours and actions are used to help children identify parts of speech in sentences.



The examples above show how children are taken through the various forms that verbs may take.

Spelling (Years 1-6)

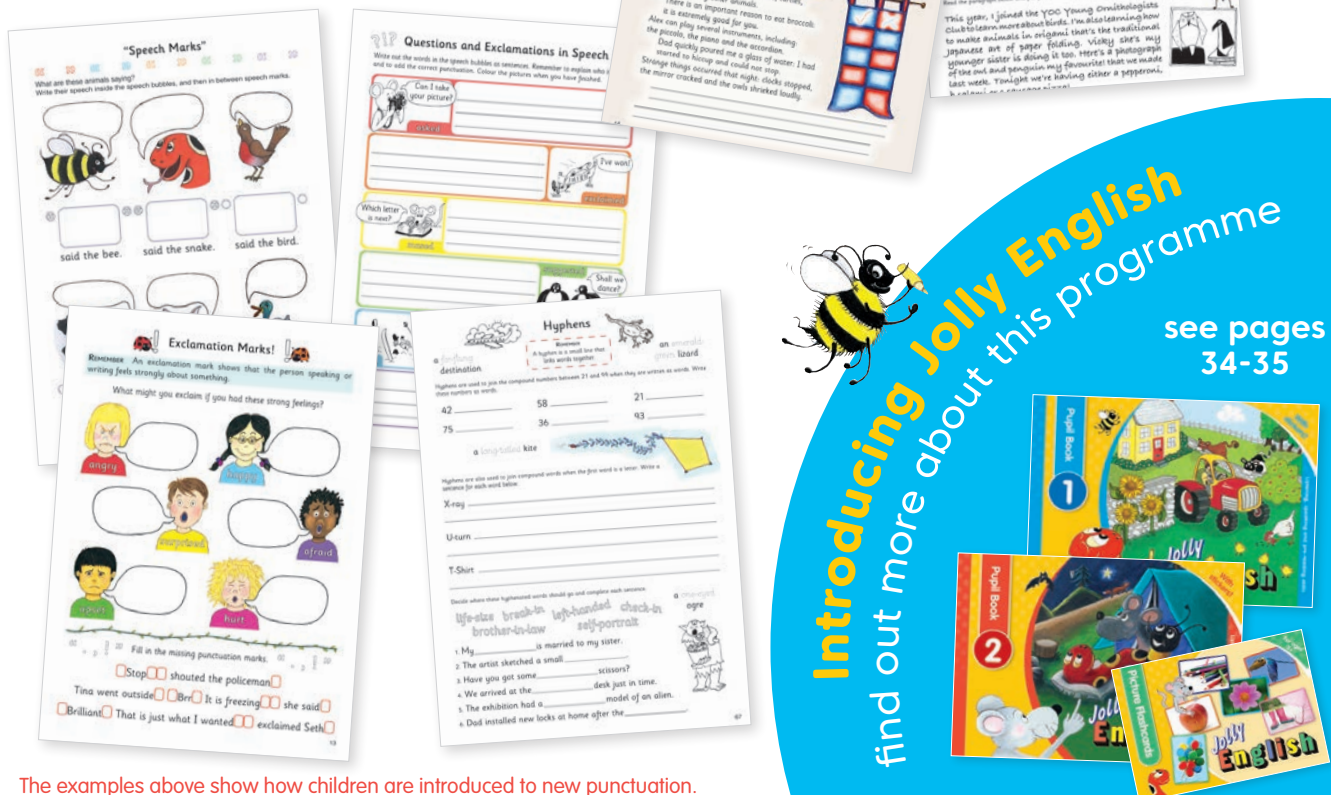
Children are initially taught one way of spelling a sound before gradually learning that the same sound can be represented in a number of different forms. They start with the common variations, before progressing to other, more unusual spelling patterns that occur as the children develop their vocabulary for reading and writing.



The examples below show how children are taken through the different spellings of the /ai/ sound.

Punctuation (Years 1-6)

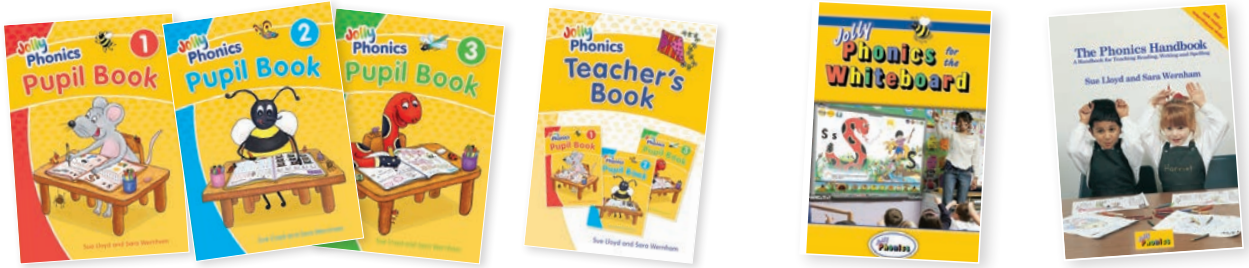
Children are introduced to punctuation concepts and continue to revise these throughout the school years. Starting with full stops and speech marks, children will then learn how to use exclamation and question marks, colons and semi-colons, hyphens, commas, bullet points and much more.

Enables you to teach the 5 key skills needed for reading and writing.

1. Learning the letter sounds

Children are taught the 42 main letter sounds. This includes alphabet sounds and digraphs, such as /sh/, /th/, /ai/ and /ue/.

2. Learning letter formation

Using different multi-sensory methods, children learn how to form and write the letters.

3. Blending

Children are taught how to blend the sounds together to read and write new words.

4. Identifying the sounds in words

Listening for the sounds in words gives children the best start for improving spelling.

5. Learning tricky words

Tricky words have irregular spellings and children learn these separately.

Letter sound order

The sounds are taught in a specific order (not alphabetically). The first group has been chosen as it makes more simple three letter words than any other six letters. This enables children to begin building words as early as possible.

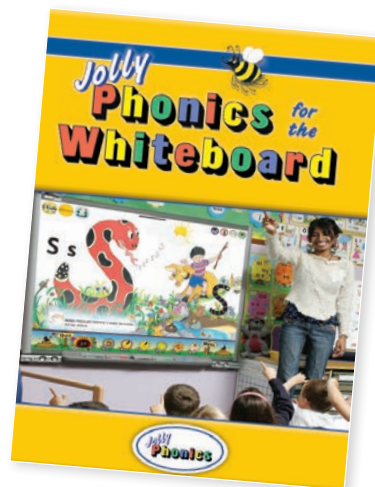

Structured daily lessons for teaching the 42 letter sounds, alternative vowels and tricky words!

Step 1 - Introduce

Provides daily flipcharts, each introducing a letter sound as well as revision of letter sounds already taught. By the end of Step 1, children should know all 42 main letter sounds and the first set of tricky words. This will enable children to blend them together to read and write simple words.

Step 2 - Build

Builds on the teaching in Step 1. Provides 12 weekly units, and follows a similar format of daily revision and consolidation along with extension topics for the week. These include additional tricky words and the alternative ways of writing the vowel sounds, as well as alphabet work.

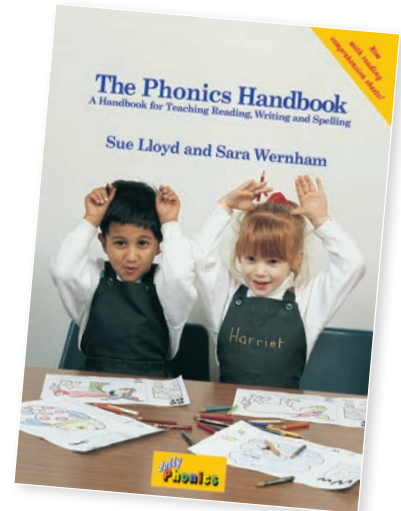

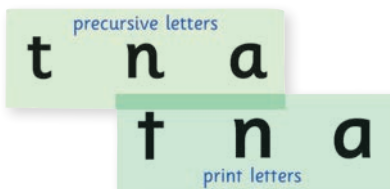

SECTION 2: SOUND SHEETS

lesson objective

Letter Sound: /ie/

Storyline: A boy is going to a party. Everyone will be wearing costumes. The boy wants to dress up as a sailor, like his dad. His dad gives him a sailor's hat and shows him how to salute. The boy stands to attention and salutes, saying /ie, ie/.

Action: The children pretend to be a sailor, saluting and saying, /ie, ie/!

Flash card: Hold up the letters /ie/, and say /ie/. Point out that although there are two letters, there is only one sound.

Letter formation: It is easier for the children to remember to write both letters if they learn to join them up. Explain how /ie/ is written. The children form the letters in the air in one continuous movement. Then they trace the dotted letters on the Sound Sheet. Finally, they write the letters on their own.

Blending: The children blend the words on the Sound Sheet, pointing to the dot underneath each sound as they say it.

Word bank: Pie, lie, die, tried, spied, fried, cried, untie, terrified.

Extension activity: Cut out and decorate paper ties.

FURTHER PHONICS
Useful information for teachers

- When two letters make one sound, it is called a 'digraph'.
- /ie/ is the long vowel sound of the vowel letter *i*.
- When long vowel sounds are written, they usually begin with the vowel letter, followed by another vowel, as in *sea*, *see*, *die*, *soar*, *que*. When two vowels go walking the first does the talking.
- /ie/ can be written as *ie*, as in 'tie', *ye*, as in 'fly', *igh*, as in 'high' and *i.e.*, as in 'like'. Once children can blend *ie* words with confidence, they can be introduced to the other spellings (Photocopy Section 13, Alternative Spelling of Vowels, pages 181 and 187-8).
- **i-e word bank:** hide, nine, life, wipe, five, line, prize, shine, slide.
- **ey word bank:** by, my, try, spy, fly, shy, cry, sly, myself, satisfy.
- **igh word bank:** sigh, thigh, right, sight, tight, fright, flight, might.
- The sound /ie/ can also be written as:
 - *ie*, as in 'child'
 - *ei*, as in 'feisty'
 - *ui*, as in 'buy'.

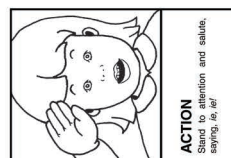

Tips for teachers and parents

- Some English words have silent letters, such as the 'e' in 'gone', which are not pronounced when the word is read. In these books, silent letters are shown in faint type. Remind the child not to read the faint letters when blending the word.
- The letter 'd' is sometimes pronounced /t/ at the ends of words such as 'hopped'. Children do not usually find this difficult, but they might need some help and guidance at the beginning of reading these words, but they might need some help and guidance at the beginning of reading these words.
- An important part of becoming a confident, fluent reader is a child's ability to understand what is read. Below are some suggestions on how to develop a child's reading comprehension.

Before tackling these Purple Level Readers, a child will need to be able to:

- Recognise the basic 42 letter sounds, e.g. as in happy and fly, the 'top-cover' or 'digraphs' in words like take, these, chin, coat and mule.
- Read (blend) regular words containing these letter sounds.

Teachers and parents

Home reading of this book is shared experience between you and the child. Try to avoid leaving it until the whole book is read before talking about it. Occasionally stop at various intervals throughout the book.

- Ask questions about the characters, the setting, the action and the meaning.

Grammar 26 – The Object of a Sentence

Aim: Refine the children's understanding of a sentence and develop their ability to identify both its subject and object.

Introduction: Review sentences and remind the children that a sentence must start with a capital letter, contain a verb, make sense, and end with a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark. Write on the board 'The farmer grows vegetables.' Choose one of the children to read it out and ask whether it is a sentence (yes). Remind them that a sentence also has to have a subject, which is the noun or pronoun that is doing or being the verb. Ask the children to identify the verb (grows) and underline it in red. Now say 'Who or what grows the vegetables?' and ask them for the subject of the sentence. Draw a box around 'farmer' and put a small 's' in the corner. Write some more simple sentences on the board and identify the verb and subject in each one.

Main point: As well as having a subject, a sentence may also have an object. Both the subject and object can be a person, place or thing, but the subject does the verb action, and the object receives the verb action. Look at the sentence on the board and ask the children what they think the object of the sentence may be. Explain that they know what the subject and verb are (the farmer grows) and they can find the object by asking 'The farmer grows what?' (vegetables). Draw a ring around the word 'vegetables' and put a small 'o' inside. Now replace 'vegetables' with the pronoun 'them' and ask which word is the object now. Explain that, like the subject, the object of a sentence is always a noun or pronoun.

Now write this pair of sentences on the board and, with the children, find the verb, subject and object in each: The black cat (subject) chased (verb) the little mouse (object); The little mouse (subject) chased (verb) the black cat (object). When the children are asked 'The black cat chased what?' to find the object of the first sentence, they may reply 'the little mouse'. This is not wrong but make sure a ring is only drawn around the noun and not any adjectives or articles that go with it.

Grammar Sheet 26: The children read each sentence, identify the verb, and underline it in red. They must remember to underline all the parts of the verb (eg 'is reading' and 'will be learning'). Then they decide who (or what) is doing the verb action and draw a box around the subject, with a small 's' in the corner. Finally they decide who or what is receiving the verb action and draw a ring around the object, with a small 'o' inside.

The subject and object in each sentence is: 1. cat (S) mouse (O) 2. rancher (S) cow (O) 3. I (S) cake (O) 4. Seth (S) ball (O) 5. lady (S) letter (O) 6. dog (S) bone (O) 7. Megan (S) door (O) 8. boy (S) comic (O) 9. artist (S) portrait (O) 10. he (S) drawer (O) 11. Grandma (S) scarf (O) 12. We (S) salad (O) 13. She (S) flute (O) 14. Joe (S) puppy (O) 15. puppy (S) Joe (O) 16. I (S) poem (O).

Extension activity: The children write some sentences of their own and identify the verb, subject and object in each one.

Rounding off: Go over the sheet with the children, checking their answers. If they have written their own sentences, ask some to read them out and identify the verb, subject and object in each one.
